S-590 Advanced Fire Behavior Interpretation Course is scheduled for March 2 - 12, 2026. S-590 candidates are strongly encouraged to participate in Geographic Area Priority Trainee Programs. Students that have incident assignments as Trainees are better prepared for the S-590 course.

With approval from their supervisor and local Training Officer, potential S-590 candidates for the 2026 course, should contact their <u>Geographic Area Training Representative (GATR)</u> to obtain information on how to participate in Regional Priority Trainee Programs. S-590 candidates may also apply to Incident Management Teams as FBAN/LTAN trainees to gain valuable experience and prepare for the upcoming course.
