#### **HAZMAT IQ: ABOVE THE LINE BELOW THE LINE**

**1 Day Class (May 11th)**

The HazMatQ system incorporates trademarked innovative street smart “Cheat Sheets” that enable responders to safely and efficiently respond to any known or unknown chemical or mixture. Students taking this course will be able to size-up (physical state, hazards, initial hot zone, correct meters and PPE) any chemical in minutes. The system then coaches responders through a streamlined chemical research method to verify their initial size-up, preparing responders to immediately go to work when they arrive on a Hazardous Materials/WMD event.

The goal of this 80 hour course is to bring personnel to, at a minimum, the recognized NFPA 1072 Hazardous Materials Technician level. First responders at the technician level are individuals who respond to releases or potential releases for the purpose of stopping the release. They assume a more aggressive role than a first responder at the operations level in that they will approach the point of release in order to plug, patch or otherwise stop the release of a hazardous substance.

#### **HAZARDOUS MATERIALS SAFETY OFFICER**

**2 Day Class (July 25th - 26th)**  
**Fountain Fire Department**  
**811 N Santa Fe Ave, Fountain**

This course prepares the Hazardous Materials Technician to fulfill the roles and responsibilities required of the position in the Incident Command System in response to hazardous materials incidents. In addition, it will assist in preparing an overall hazardous materials response management program and protocols. The Hazardous Materials Safety Officer position within the Incident Command System is a required position when responding to a defined hazardous materials incident. The person filling this role must possess the training, experience, and education, and shall be defined as a Hazardous Materials Technician in accordance with 29 CFR 1910.120(q).

This educational course is based on the requirements spelled out in 2008 NFPA 1072 and will provide the participant with the education needed to successfully perform at a hazardous materials incident as a HazMat Safety Officer. By law, technicians can only be appointed Hazmat Safety Officer; however any person interested in hazardous materials safety, or involved in program management, will take great interest in the concepts, objectives and curriculum within this course and is encouraged to attend.

#### **HAZARDOUS MATERIALS HIGHWAY SPECIALIST COURSE**

**2 Week Course (April 15th - April 19th)**

**Adams County Fire Protection District**

This class provides those who are or will be operating as a member of a Hazmat Team (fire department or law enforcement agency) the essential skills needed to evaluate and work defensively or offensively at an incident involving the release of hazardous materials. This course is designed to prepare emergency responders to deal with hazardous materials incidents specifically related to highway transportation. This includes chemical cargo tanks and dry vans. Topics include container features, valves, venting systems, basic repairs, drilling and transfer techniques, and grounding and bonding, incorporated into an extensive hands on experience.

**CAMEO COURSE**

**3 Day Course (August 5th - August 7th)**  
**Larkspur Fire Protection District**  
**9414 S Spruce Mtn Dr, Larkspur**

This course is designed for those wishing to utilize the CAMEO software suite (CAMEO Chemicals, CAMEOfm, MARPLOT and ALOHA) for all-hazards emergency planning and response. It is recommended (but not required) that all participants have some experience with data entry to the CAMEO and/or MARPLOT software applications. Linkages between the CAMEO programs and other software applications (Google Earth, EXCEL, WORD and ArcGIS) are explored in depth. Participants learn methods to transfer large amounts of data between CAMEOfm and EXCEL, as well as transferring mapping data into MARPLOT from shapefiles and spreadsheets. Each student will receive a pdf file of the three ALOHA Technical Documents, which are used to supplement the course material. Instruction is accomplished by exploring various chemical release scenarios taken from actual events.
