TRAINING ANNOUNCEMENT:

Nomination period now open for S-341, GIS Specialist for Incident Management 2024 Courses

S-341, GIS Specialist for Incident Management does not teach ArcGIS (ArcGIS Pro) functionality or concepts. As GIS professionals, students must have expertise using ArcGIS technology and should come to the class already proficient at managing/**editing** geospatial data (geodatabases), using **feature templates**, running analysis, using queries, creating a **map series**, using **bookmarks**, and map layout production using **ArcGIS Pro** software. COURSE INFORMATION:

There will be **two sessions** of S-341 offered in the Wildland Fire Learning Portal with **50 seats** available in each session. Each session held over a two-week period. No tuition is charged for this course.

- **Session 1: February 26-29 & March 4-7, 2024**
- **Session 2: April 8-11 & April 15-18, 2024**

There are 50-60 total course hours for S-341.

- ❖ Pre-course work takes approximately 4 hours.
- ❖ Week 1 takes approximately 20 hours.
- ❖ Week 2 course time is approximately 32 hours.

Supervisor approval is **required**. You **must** have supervisor approval to participate in the course **before** completing the nomination form. Supervisors **must** agree to allow you ample amount of work time to complete required pre-course work. Supervisors **must** agree to allow you ample amount of work time to complete week 1 of the session, which is self-paced, but will take you approximately 20 hours. And lastly (and most importantly) your supervisor **must** agree that for week 2, you will *only* be working on this course, as if you are sitting in a classroom in Denver. There will be little to no time to do your regular job Monday-Thursday of week 2.

NOMINATION:

There are **two components** of the S-341 nomination process.

- ✓ Fill out a **Nomination Form** and select session preference.
- ✓ Complete a **Pre-selection assessment GIS exercise**. This timed exercise will evaluate your GIS skills using ArcGIS Pro. It will cover data creation and editing, attribution, simple analysis, and a map layout. **You will be given 4 hours to complete the exercise**. You will only be able to submit your map once.

NOMINATION DEADLINE IS NOVEMBER 1, 2023, AT 17:00 PDT. NO EXTENSIONS WILL BE GIVEN.

NOTE: You **MUST** have a laptop or desktop computer with internet connectivity, **ArcGIS Pro 3.x installed** (installed locally - not VDI), and an ArcGIS **Pro license** to complete the nomination process and participate in the course. Contact your agency IT specialist for assistance. We cannot assist with ArcGIS Pro licenses for pre-selection. [Check computer specifications](#) needed to run ArcGIS Pro.

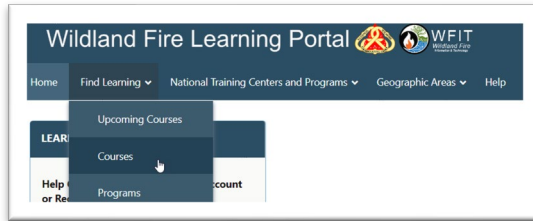
